

**MEMORANDUM FOR STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM BETWEEN
NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, TIRUCHIRAPALLI (NITT) AND
NAGOYA INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (NIT)**

In accordance with the Agreement for Academic Exchange and Cooperation between National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirapalli (NITT) and Nagoya Institute of Technology (NIT), the two Universities agree to exchange students under the following terms and conditions :

1. The Memorandum covers the exchange of undergraduate and graduate students. Hereinafter "exchange student" shall mean the student participating in the Student Exchange Program implemented herein.
2. Exchange students shall not be liable to examination fees, registration fees and tuition fees to the host University.
3. Exchange students shall be liable to all the expenses except the fees mentioned above.
4. The number of exchange students accepted by the host University shall not exceed 2 (two) per year. The period of attendance at the host University for exchange students shall not exceed 1 (one) year.
5. Each exchange student accepted by each University shall have the status of "special undergraduate student" or "special graduate student".
6. Exchange students shall possess language ability sufficient for comprehension of lectures and for carrying on a research work at the host University
7. Each University can recognize academic credits awarded or course work assessed by the host University for its own exchange students upon their request, according to the criteria and the procedure of the home University
8. Each University shall have the permission in advance from the host University when the home University selects its own exchange student(s).
9. Each exchange student shall be responsible for his/her medical and other forms of personal insurance.

Supplementary Provision

- i) This Memorandum will become effective on the date of its signature and remain in effect for five years from the date it is signed. The validity of the Memorandum may be extended when mutually agreeable to both parties.
- ii) Amendments to and termination of the Memorandum must be done by a written agreement between National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirapalli (NITT) and Nagoya Institute of Technology (NIT),
- iii) The Memorandum written in English is the authentic copy.

**AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND COOPERATION
BETWEEN
NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, TIRUCHIRAPALLI (NITT)
AND
NAGOYA INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (NIT)**

National Institute of Technology, Tiruchirapalli (NITT) and Nagoya Institute of Technology (NIT), to develop academic exchange and cooperation in education and research between the two institutions, have agreed as follows :

- I. Based upon the principles of respect for each others' independence and of mutual benefit, the two institutions will carry out the following activities :
 - a) Exchange of students
 - b) Exchange of Professors, Research scholars and staffs
 - c) Exchange of scientific materials, publications and information
 - d) Joint Research activities
- II. In order to carry out above-mentioned activities, a detailed plan is to be formed after consultation between the two institutions
- III. This agreement may be revised or terminated upon mutual consultation and consent between the two institutions
- IV. This agreement comes into force on the day when representatives of the two institutions affix their signatures, and is valid for five years. This agreement is renewed automatically as long as neither party gives notice of termination to the other
- V. The notice of termination of this agreement needs to be given six months in advance
- VI. The agreement written in English is the authentic copy.
