MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

The University of Rennes 1, A public establishment with scientific, cultural and professional missions « Établissement Public à Caractère Scientifique, Culturel et Professionnel (EPCSCP) », Headquarters is located at: 2 rue du Thabor - CS 46510 - 35065 Rennes Cedex, FRANCE, and represented by the President, Guy CATHELINEAU, elected on the 30th of May 2008 by the Board of Directors

and

The National Institute of Technology, A centrally funded technical institution with an 'Institute of National Importance' status, Head quarters is located at: Tanjore Main Road, National Highway 67, Tiruchirappalli 620015, TamilNadu, INDIA, and represented by the Director, S. Sundarrajan, elected on 1st July 2011 by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.

- This agreement represents an initial undertaking on the part of the National Institute of Technology, -Tiruchirappalli, India (hereafter referred to as NIT-T) and the University of Rennes 1, France (hereafter referred to as UR1) to start a cooperation including undergraduate teaching at the Master level in the International Master programme "Molecular Catalysis and Green Chemistry" (hereby referred to as MCGC).
- The applications of the best students selected at NIT-T at the Master 1 level in Chemistry will be 2 examined preferentially by the teaching committee of MCGC at UR1.
- The number of students will be initially limited to f or 2 according to their previous academic 3 records.
- The acceptance will not be automatic; the selection of the students will be made by the teaching 4 committee of the MCGC master according to the rules of the University of Rennes 1.
- NIT-T will be responsible for the academic standards and quality of the students proposed for this 5 master programme.
- UR1 will not be engaged for the future of the students concerning further studies and their search for 6 Ph.D. grants.
